ZONE 23 SHOW RIDING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2008

Information: PCA Rules apply.

Beginners: for 11 years and under only. To be held in a fully enclosed arena.
Led and Unled divisions for each class.
Point score sashes for winners and runners up in led and unled divisions.

Intermediate: For riders who have not won 2 firsts in a riding class at a gymkhana/show at this level or above.

Two age groups in intermediate ring: Under 13 years, 13 years and over.
Point score sashes for winners and runners up in both age groups.

Open Ring: Riders from Zone 23 who wish to qualify for PCA State Show Riding MUST compete at this event at open level. You must bring all entry documentation for State Show Riding with you and give it to our ZCI, Jill Hawker, on the day.

Open Age Groups: Under 9 years, 9 & under 11 yrs, 11 & under 13 yrs, 13 & under 15 yrs, 15 & under 17 yrs, Associates. Age groups may be combined if entries low.

Zone Champion and Reserve Champion in each age group for Zone 23 members.

Out of Zone point score sashes for winners and runners up in open ring for under 13 years and 13 years and over.

Working Hunter (Open Ring) - EFA rules adapted for pony club- judged over 2 phases.

Phase 1: a workout on the flat, including gallop (50 points)

Phase 2: a course of 8 jumps. (100 points)

There will be four jumping heights offered: **25 cm** (includes ungraded riders), **45 cm**, **60 cm**, **75cm**.

Both phases to be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Leg protection in jumping phase only.

Competitors may enter any height class at or below the height they are graded for.

Working Show Hunter (Intermediate Ring) Two small jumps (25cm) will be included in the ridden workout. Judged in one phase. Snaffle bit only.

Jumping Rider (Beginners' Ring) Riders' style will be judged over ground poles.

Pony Club Mount and Pleasure Hack to be ridden in a snaffle bridle, cavesson noseband, no whips or spurs. Pony Club Mount/Rider will involve a short course of tasks e.g. bending, mugs

One horse/one rider

Team of Four tryouts for Zone 23 (Under 13 years, 13 & under 17 years) to be held after all events are finished in the afternoon.

The judges' decisions are final.

The only protests considered will be where a breach of PCA rules is questioned, addressed to the show riding coordinator, Catriona, on the day.
