

Qualifications for state Competition

To enter in State Pony Club Champion Events, the horse and rider combination must attend three working rallies of a pony club, in the previous twelve (12) months, two of which must have been at the club which they will be representing. Refer to the specific regulations for competition entry, as well as Club/Zone guidelines.

Both horse and rider must be present for a minimum of 4 hours at a Working Rally to qualify as a horse and rider combination. Qualifications must be fully gained prior to the close of Entries to any state Championship.

The dates on which Associate members attend their own Pony Club rallies to help and coach, may be recorded as rallies attended, provided that the qualifying mount is known to the Club Instructor / Zone Chief Instructor to be competent at Pony Club activities.
