

State Events 2006

If you are planning to try to qualify for state events you should be planning ahead! If you have any questions about this please talk to Jill. The dates are on the calender and entries close 6 weeks before. PCA NEVER accept late entries and the entries need to be to Jill Hawker the Tuesday prior to the closing date to allow processing.

To qualify for ALL state events you must have attended 3 rally days in the last 12 months on the horse you wish to ride.

You must also attend the zone event in that discipline. This will only be waived in exceptional circumstances and you must apply in writing to Jill Hawker prior to the event. Your application will then be considered in consultation with the zone committee. If you or your horse are injured or unfit on the day you will need to supply a doctors or vet certificate.

You must then also achieve the qualifying standards set out by PCA and by the zone.

These are;

Sporting- Times in at least 2 of these 4 events

5 Flag Race Under 12s- 47 secs

 All others- 44 secs

Bending All – 12 secs

Barrel Race All - 21 secs

Bonfields Bounce All- 35 secs

Equitation

Performance must be of suitable standard at the zone equitation.

Outside performance is not necessary but will be taken into account.

Showjumping

Under 13 years- B grade

13 and under 15 A grade- max starting height 90- 1.05

15 and under 17 A grade- max starting height 1.05- 1.20

Associates- A grade- max starting height 1.05- 1.20

Outside performance to show ability over the bigger courses is necessary especially in the 15 and over .

Eventing

12 and under 15 years novice- C grade Intro HT

13 and under 15 years advanced – B grade Prelim HT

15 and under 17 years novice – B grade Prelim HT

15 and under 17 years advanced- A grade Pre-novice HT

17 and under 25 years novice- A grade Pre-novice HT

!7 and under 25 years advanced- Championship grade-
Novice HT

You also require 2 outside horse trials at the level entered with no elimination.

Dressage

This year the tests were.

Under 13- 1.4 and 2.1

13 and under 15- 2.1 and 2.3

15 and under 17- 2.3 and 3.1

Associates- 3.1 and 3.3.

You will need performance at the level you will be riding allowing for your age next January. Some performance outside Pony Club as well is preferable with scores over 55%
